- c. Use the chat platform responsibly.
- d. Respect the privacy and personal information of other users

- e. Be tolerant towards other people's viewpoints. It is okay to respectfully disagree.
- f. Posting memes, jokes or related are allowed, however, please make sure the material does not contain contents that are considered offensive to the local culture / contents.
- g. Be respectful to local culture.

All visitors on are strictly not allowed to:

- a. No trolling.
- b. No Spamming. Any messages that are irrelevant to the content of NASA Space Apps Challenge will be considered as Spam and will not be tolerated.
- c. Post harsh, vulgar, profanity words; in any languages.
- d. Bullying or make inflammatory remarks to other community members
- e. Posts about politics or any issues that might lead to provocation
- g. Make personal attacks or provocation on other users.
- h. Spread personal information of other people without consent.
- i. Use defamatory remarks or make false statements against others.
- j. Post prejudiced remarks.
- k. Threatening other users, either intentionally or unintentionally.
- l. Attacking the moderator, either in a public space channel or in private.
- m. Soft-selling, or promoting monetary services that are not related to the focus of the event.

Consequences

We will take serious action if we see someone violating these guidelines as follows:

- a. Comments / Posts / Chats that go against our community guidelines will be deleted.
- b. Users will be banned from entering the site.
- c. Reports for Spam or other relevant reports will be made to the profile to the respective website owners.
- d. Revoke certain privileges or accounts entirely.
